TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER

WHEREAS, the plaintiff has demonstrated through its affidavits and verified complaint that it will suffer irreparable injury through the defendants' sale of the Stamford Advocate newspaper if temporary injunctive relief is not granted; and

WHEREAS, the application for a temporary restraining order (document no. 8) is otherwise in compliance with Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 65;

NOW THEREFORE, it is ordered that the defendants, Southern Connecticut Newspapers, Inc., and the Tribune Company are restrained and enjoined from completing the sale of the Stamford Advocate until the court convenes a hearing on the plaintiff's motion for a preliminary injunction (document no. 6), presently set down for March 28, 2007.

Pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 65(c), the plaintiff shall post bond with the court in the amount of

\$50,000.
